The Options Academy, Inc. (OAI), a pending 501(c) 3 non-profit organization, is excited to announce its new program to offer guidance to young men who exhibit the ability to succeed in life with the assistance of resources and support. Headquartered in Oakland, CA, OAI was conceived and founded by Charles M. Lovelace in 2007 with a commitment to youth/young men and aiding them to independence using a holistic approach to address body, soul, spirit & mind.

Our pilot program will meet every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 3:30 – 7 pm at the Family Resources House of Unity located at 7200 Bancroft Blvd., Suite 230 in Oakland beginning May 19 through August 20. During this time, students will participate in various topic discussions such as financial literacy, manhood and respect for themselves and others, especially females.

There are a variety of different ways you can help make a difference. One of them is by sponsoring one or more of the following program components:

- Four month program registration fee of \$195 (includes administrative costs, Life Skill book, Academy shirt and hat)
- Life Skills book - \$55
- Academy shirt and hat - \$2
- Self defense course - \$60 (6 hours)
- Fee for gun range education - \$45
- Facility rental fee - \$150
- Facilitators fee - \$50 (2 hours)

You may also sponsor a student each month for \$385 or \$1540 for entire four month session (Both costs do not include initial registration fee or travel and expenses for trips that exceed 15 miles one way).

While these costs represent some of the needs of the program, we do welcome non-financial support to ensure that the program is successful and our young men walk away with the skills and resources they need to give them a competitive edge.
